The completely closed natural gas fireplace draws combustion air directly from outside the building. It requires little installation and avoids having to have a chimney installed, which is a much more expensive undertaking.



Take care with original designs

Whether your fireplace is prefabricated or custom-designed, it must meet manufacturing and installation standards.

If your original design does not meet manufacturing and installation standards, you will have to have it approved on-site by a recognized certification organization* so you can be sure that your fireplace conforms.
